

Camper and Camp Personnel Protocol

In order to protect our campers and all staff personnel, the following protocol has been adopted for all summer camps regarding the Camp Drug and Alcohol Policy:

Any Camper or Counselor in Training (Vporyadnyk) or Camp Personnel found drinking or under the influence of alcoholic beverages, using or under the influence of drugs or illegal substances on camp grounds, including possession of any of the aforementioned and including Sunday off premises "free time", or in violation of the Camp Drug and Alcohol Policy Statement, will be subject to:

- Immediate notification of the parents or legal guardians who will be required to
 pick up or make arrangements for the pick up and removal from U.A.Y.A.
 property of the camper /Counselor in Training within 12 hours. Beyond 12
 hours, accommodations and supervision will be provided at parental expense.
- Immediate expulsion from the camp grounds.
- Forfeiture of stipend.
- No refund of camp fees.
- Prohibited from attending or working any remaining camps for the season, as
 well as for future seasons. In addition, he/she will not be permitted to attend or
 take part in any camp ground functions (this includes but is not limited to camp
 fires, dances, social gatherings, sporting events or similar events) for the
 duration of the season. In order to be considered for future participation as a
 counselor in training or camp personnel, that individual must formally petition
 the Camp Commission in writing, explaining why they should be considered for
 reinstatement.
- Future admission to U.A.Y.A property in Ellenville for the season will be at the discretion of the Administration.

I have read the Camp Drug and Alcohol Policy Statement, as well as the above Camper and Camp Personnel Protocol, and agree to be bound by their terms and abide by the rules stated.
