YOU ARE REQUIRED TO SUBMIT YOUR CHILD'S REGISTRATION FORM THROUGH YOUR LOCAL BRANCH.

B. NON-MEMBERS

Non-member registrations will be permitted only for the recreational camp (applications will be considered after June 2).
 An additional fee of \$75 per child applies. The child must buy an odnostrij (CYM-shirt).

C. REFUNDS

Only in September after the end of the camping season will the Camp Commitee issue any refunds based on the written medical diagnosis that the camper is unfit to attend the camp ing program.

INFORMATION FOR PARENTS AND CAMPERS

- Tabir (camp) begins on Sunday, July 15, 2012.
- All taborovyky (campers) are to arrive at tabir between the hours of 2:00 4:00 p.m. for their official registration. The gates will not be open until 1:00pm
- The official opening ceremony will commence at 5:00 pm with a liturgy in full *odnostroji* (uniforms).

1. CAMP FEES

- Full payment must be sent to your CYM Branch by June 17, 2012 along with the following documents (refer to addresses on page 4):
 - registration form
 - medical form
 - picture of child

WITHOUT FULL PAYMENT WE WILL NOT ACCEPT YOUR CHILD FOR CAMP

2. REGISTRATION

- ♦ The program for the first day of tabir is as follows:
 - registration
 - Liturgy and official *vidkrytia* (opening ceremony)
 - diner (all taborovyky are required to attend)
- At registration, the taborovyky will be assigned a palanka (cabin).
- Only after registration may the parents install their children in their designated palanky.
- The following administrative items are to be completed and/or submitted upon registration at the *tabir*:
 - permission form
 - medical form
 - any additional medical information (healthcard number)

ALL CLOTHING AND PERSONAL ARTICLES SHOULD HAVE THE CHILD'S NAME CLEARLY INSCRIBED TO IDENTIFY OWNERSHIP

9.3 PROHIBITED ITEMS


If any of the following items are found they will be taken away and returned at the end of *tabir*.

- cell phones
- personal listening devices (IPod, Walkman, etc.)
- personal entertainment systems (Nintendo, SEGA, etc.)
- plug coolers, fans, etc. (no electrical appliances)
- any media not printed or recorded in Ukrainian
- food in the palanky
- knives
- matches and lighters

If any of the following items are found in the possession of a camper, he\she will be sent home.

- alcohol
- cigarettes
- narcotics

9.2 GENERAL ITEMS /continued/

Clothing

- underwear
- socks
- two (2) pairs of pajamas
- a sleeping bag is obligatory (one of the experiences that the children will have at *tabir* will be to sleep in tents)
- bedsheets are required indoors
- a plastic sheet to cover the mattress
- pillow
- running shoes
- rubber boots
- light footwear to be worn in the palanka

Personal Hygiene

- one small towel for morning and evening wash-up
- one large towel for swimming
- toothbrush and toothpaste
- soap and shampoo
- comb/brush
- hair pins and elastics
- tissues (1 box)
- sunscreen (#25, or higher)
- insect repellent non aerosol

Miscellaneous

- a flashlight
- an old blanket to be used during vatra (camp bonfire)
- stationary supplies: paper, pens, pencils (black and colored), envelopes, list of addresses, stamps
- a suitcase or knapsack in which all items are to be stored
- a plastic bag or old pillow case for soiled clothing
- a baseball glove, soccer cleats, shin guards
- goggles & watershoes and\or sandals for the pool

3. ALLOWANCE

We do not encourage you to let your children bring valuables or money. There is no need for them at *tabir*. If you wish, you can deposit a small amount of money with the *kramnytsia* (tuckshop) for your child's use.

4. VISITING PRIVILEGES

- VISITATION IS ALLOWED ONLY ON SUNDAYS AFTER 11:00am AND UNTIL 5:00 pm. At this time the taborovyky are the sole responsibility of their parents.
- THE KOMANDA (Camp Administration) MUST BE ADVISED IF A CHILD IS LEAVING THE PREMISES OF CAMP WESELKA. The child MUST be accompanied by his/her parents.
- ◆ FAMILIY OR FRIENDS WISHING TO TAKE A CHILD OFF THE PREMISES MUST INDICATE PARENTAL PERMISSION.
- AT ALL TIMES, other than on Sunday between lunch and supper, IS ENTRY TO THE IMMEDIATE AREA OF THE *TABIR* PROHIBITED WITHOUT FORMAL PERMISSION OF THE *KOMANDA*.
- ALL VISITORS MUST REPORT TO KOMANDA UPON ARRIVAL.

5. MEDICAL NEEDS

- Parking is restricted to the parking lots near the ponds.
- All *taborovyky* and members of the *taborova komanda* must present their medical form to the Camp Nurse upon arrival.
- If your child requires medication, whether for a sickness or for allergies. the medication is to be given to the camp nurse. It must be accompanied by a clear and precise description from the doctor of the prescription type, the dosage, and frequency at which it is to be administered.
- ◆ IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE PARENTS TO INFORM THE CAMP NURSE OF ANY SPECIFIC MEDICAL NEEDS OR ALLERGIES YOUR CHILD MIGHT HAVE AND TO REVIEW THESE WITH HIM/HER (THIS IS PARTICULARLY RELEVANT IF YOUR CHILD IS ALLERGIC TO PEANUTS).
- In addition, we strongly advise you to read the enclosed brochure concerning the West Nile Virus.

6. OFFICIAL CLOSING/DEPARTURE

- The official closing of the tabir will take place on Friday, August 3 at 6:30 p.m.Parents who registered children for two weeks, sign their child out on Sunday, July 29 after 11:00am. Entry for all parents and guests into the tabir area is not per mitted until the program is completed.
- It is the responsibility of parents to ensure all accounts are settled before departure.
- Parents must ensure that they leave the palanka in a clean state before departure.
