National Shooting Day – Sunday 25th March 2007

Rules

The course of fire will be arranged as follows:-

The competitors will be allowed one sitting in card of five shots each. After these sitting in cards, depending on numbers, the competitors will shoot up to 5 competition cards. The person with the highest score over the 5 cards will be the winner.

Each Competitor will write their name on their own target and all targets will be checked by the range officer.

The issue of disputed marking will be addressed by the club chairman, in the event of any dispute with the chief score person, whose decision is final, as per the NSRA (National Small-bore Rifle Association) regulations 2001. The score person will use the NSRA regulation .177 rifle and pistol scoring gauges as stipulated in the NSRA regulations 2001.

All range instructions will be delivered by the duty range officers. Any person found to be in contravention of any range officers command or any range regulation will be asked to leave the range immediately. The health and safety of the competitors is paramount and every attempt to ensure their safety will be taken.

Competitors not actively taking part on the range will be asked to stay behind the firing line in the clubhouse. The competitors not shooting will also be asked to maintain a quiet atmosphere conducive for the competitors on the firing line.

All the competition details will be shot in the standing position at the firing point without resting or leaning on the bench. The latter will be a disqualifying offence. The only detractors to the aforementioned regulations will be on the field target range where the competitors will be actively encouraged to adopt sitting, kneeling, crouching and standing positions.
