



N.B. The purpose for this information is to inform prospective attendees of specific competition information including detail specifics, times, team information, target information, scoring, registration details, costs, facilities etc.

- Competition:** NSD10; aka National Shooting Day, Teams of four maximum. £20.00 per team entrance fee
- Purpose:** Normally an occasion for all and sundry to turn up, have a shoot and basically try shooting as a sport.  
To mark the tenth anniversary of NSD, 2010 NSD10 will consist of an inter-Oseredok competition for rifle/pistol.
- Details:** There will only be a rifle detail programmed unless registration numbers permit the inclusion of a pistol and owners own details too.
- Registration:** Registration will be by e-mail from the Oseredok Holova, who will ensure that all team members are paid up CYM members, not necessarily of their own Oseredok.  
Physical proof of membership will be required for perusal by the Chief Scorer/Chairman. [N.B. KU requirement]  
Registration costs will cover administration, targets, pellets and use of club equipment.
- Equipment:** The competition will be shot using Halychyna weapons only. These include Cometa 50s, Cometa 100s, Weihrauch HW25s and possibly Weihrauch HW40 pistols.  
There is a spread of weapon sizes and weights to suit most competitors but the pistol is chosen for its ambidextrous grip.  
All the weapons have been in Halychyna use for the past ten years with the exception of the HW40s which were obtained seven years ago.  
As all the Halychyna ranges utilise the same equipment it has been decided that the competition will also use the same equipment to present a level playing field for all.
- Sights:** Only iron sights will be allowed, no scopes or dioptres although NSRA rulebook approved orthotics will be allowed.
- QC:** All the competition weapons will be cleaned and serviced before the competition and sighted in at the W-o-T range.  
All sighting-in cards will be available for viewing at the range.
- Targets:** Targets will be provided by Halychyna and will have to be signed in the presence of the chief scorer before they are shot in the competition.  
Historically, Halychyna have used 10m air pistol targets for rifle competitions in the past and in the interests of "fluidity" they will be used for NSD10 rifle competitions too.  
Halychyna are fully aware of the existence of a dedicated 10m individual 5-shot target.  
No other targets may be used.  
Non-compliance with the rules will result in disqualification.
- Pellets:** Halychyna will provide Hobby .177 wad cutter pellets for the competition.  
Non-compliance with the rules will result in disqualification.
- Clothing:** As this competition is intended to welcome all, no special shooting clothing will be allowed except for medical reasons.
- Timings:** Once all the registrations have been accepted, a clearer picture of competitor numbers will allow more accurate competition timings to be agreed.  
It is anticipated that teams will shoot together, thereby necessitating the attendance of all team members during that teams shoot.  
Latecomers will not be allowed to shoot, although there may be a possibility to rearrange the team shooting schedule to allow for such instances but the Chairman's decision will be final.
- Training:** Competing Oseredky are encouraged to start training, if they haven't already, at their local Oseredok's facilities.  
If your local Oseredok doesn't have any facilities then please contact Halychyna or your local Oseredok Holova or sports representative to arrange for training.  
Training is available at the following facilities, bearing in mind that these facilities will provide use of competition allowed equipment: Weston on Trent, Oldham, Bolton and possibly Waltham Cross.
- Parking:** Will be in the Hospoda car-park opposite the Kantselyariya, please park sensibly and with respect for other car-park and Hospoda users.
- Catering:** Catering will be dependent upon numbers but hopefully warm food and drinks will be available on the day.  
Please maintain your environment and dispose of your used items sensibly in the bins provided.
- Presentation:** There will be a presentation ceremony immediately after the competition has concluded and the winners have been identified.
