Information for parents of participants of Starshyj and Molodshyj Youth Camps – 2008

CHECK-IN information– ALL campers MUST check-in prior to entering camp sites!

- **Late payments, including all late fees, must be made at time of check-in! Without full payments camp participation will be denied.**
- It is **REQUIRED** (Wisconsin regulation) that we receive completed and signed **MEDICAL FORMS AND WAIVER AND PROOF OF INSURANCE** by the time of check-in. **WE CANNOT ACCEPT ANY CAMPERS WITHOUT THESE FORMS!**
- You may purchase camp t-shirts at this time – cost \$10.00

ALL Starshyj and Molodshyj Youth campers:

- **PARTICIPANTS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED AT THE CAMP SITES PRIOR TO DATES AND TIMES GIVEN**
- All camp participants who will be sleeping at the camps (tents or barracks) must provide their own sleeping cots
- It is **REQUIRED** that all camp participants must have a **COMPLETE AUYA UNIFORM!!!** Non-members uniform: khaki long-sleeved shirt, brown skirt/pants, matching socks, belt, tie (green for molodshyj, maroon for starshyj). Ties may be purchased at registration (cost \$7.00)
- Campers are not allowed to bring specific items. Please refer to the enclosed “List of Articles for Camp” as a reference. Only participants of Starshyj Youth Camp may bring a small pocket knife.

Starshyj Youth Camp:

- **Check-in** – Sunday, June 29 at 2:00pm; Campers must help to set up camps
- **Opening ceremony** (“Vidkryttia”) – Sunday, June 29 at 5:00pm after the camps have been set up
- **Bonfire** (“Vatra”) – Saturday, July 5 and Friday, July 11; Family and guests are invited!
- **Free time** (“Dozvillia”) – Sunday, July 6 between lunch and dinner time. Camp participants may leave only after the parents or a designated adult sign them out.
- **Closing ceremony** (“Zakryttia”) – Saturday, July 12 at approximately 11:30pm (after the campgrounds have been cleared and cleaned) After the camp closings we cannot assume responsibility for the campers.

Molodshyj Youth Camp:

- **Check-in** – Sunday, July 13 from 1:00 to 3:00pm; Participants may move into the camp **ONLY AFTER THEY HAVE “CHECKED IN”**
- **Opening ceremony** (“Vidkryttia”) – Sunday, July 13 at 4:00pm after the camps have been set up
- **Bonfire** (“Vatra”) – Saturday, July 19 and Friday, July 25; Family and guests are invited!
- **Free time** (“Dozvillia”) – Sunday, July 20 between lunch and dinner time. Camp participants may leave only after the parents or a designated adult sign them out.
- **Closing ceremony** (“Zakryttia”) – Saturday, July 26 at approximately 11:00pm (after the campgrounds have been cleared and cleaned) After the camp closings we cannot assume responsibility for the campers. Participants of Soccer camp will not be accepted prior to July 27!
