United Ukrainian Women's Organizations Of America, Inc., at mass rally of protest held Sunday, February 26, 1956 in New York, have resolved unanimously to call your attention to an act of deliberate murder committeed by Soviet authorities upon five hundred Ukrainian women in concentration camp of Kingir Karaganda by ordering heavy tanks against these defenseless women and crushing them to death. We earnestly request that this matter be brought to the attention of the United Nations for proper investigation on motion of the United States delegate to United Nations.
